In the event of a fire, Master Lock® will replace your safe free of charge.

### Flood defence

*Floods and freak weather appear to be an ever increasing occurrence in the UK, where 10% of the population now live in areas designated a flood risk.*

Master Lock® safes offer water protection up to 20cm in depth for 24 hours and its security chests will remain fully watertight even when completely submerged
